- Help install artworks and attachments (possible stepladder work)
- Install garden gazebo and info booth setup
- Help unpack/ pack up items from crates
- Help general tidy up

7. PAID POSITION: Onsite CREATIVE VOLUNTEER MANAGER

Hours: 10am – 4pm Saturday 24 October and 10 – 7pm Sunday 25 October

This will involve chatting to people, offering assistance and suggestions and helping them use the art materials onsite (pencils, crayons, glue, coloured paper water colours....). The Team will change over in three-hour shifts.

We are looking for a creative person with experience, presenting a community art project and managing volunteers, to oversee and facilitate the Creative Volunteer Team.

The Creative Volunteer Manager position involves:

1. following up volunteers to ensure they are onsite,
2. sign volunteers on/off site and complete relevant OH&S forms
3. monitor and facilitate volunteers' performance and well-being and report to the Site Coordinator
4. work with the Creative Team to facilitate the public's involvement
